PHL CONSUL GENERAL'S OFFICIAL RESIDENCE WINS AWARD

14 November 2017, Agana, Guam – The “Demolition of Existing Structure and Construction of New Official Residence of the Consul General of the Philippines,” a project of the Philippine Consulate General contracted to BME & Sons, Inc. in August 2016, and completed in May 2017, was awarded the 2017 Guam Contractors Association (GCA) Excellence in Construction Merit Award, during the GCA annual Excellence in Construction Awards and Contractor of the Year event on 3 November 2017 at the Dusit Thani.

The Official Residence of the Consul General in Guam, which consists of 980 sq.m. lot and an existing residential building, is owned by the Government of the Philippines and has served as the official residence of the Consul General of the Philippines since it was acquired 47 years ago in 1969. The old structure had to be torn down to give way to the construction of a new three-story official residence. BME & Sons, Inc. was awarded the public tender for the demolition of the existing structure and the construction of the new official residence located in Jonestown, one of the most prestigious residential districts on Guam.

The construction of the new official residence was completed in May 2017 and is expected to be inaugurated in early 2018. It features a new Rizal monument constructed by BME & Sons on the property grounds. It will also be furnished with stylish and customized furniture/decors and art works from the Philippines. –END
