### **2019 Foreign Service Officers Examinations**

The Philippine Consulate General is pleased to announce that the Board of Foreign Service Examinations (BFSE) of the Philippine Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) will be conducting the following **2019 examinations for Foreign Service Officers (FSOs)**:

Part I	Qualifying Test	27 January 2019
Part II	Preliminary Interview	To be announced
Part III	Written Test	To be announced
Part IV	Psychological Test	To be announced
Part V	Oral Test	To be announced

Applicants should comply with the following criteria/requirements:

- The applicant should be a natural-born Filipino citizen and must present a copy of her/his valid passport and visa or a valid contract of employment in the host country (if applicable);
- The applicant should be a holder of at least a four (4) year bachelor's degree or higher. Submission of relevant documents such as transcript of records, diploma or certificate of graduation is required;
- The applicant should have undergone employment or undertaken further studies for at least two (2) years after graduating from college or university.
- If married to a foreigner, the applicant must secure from the Secretary of Foreign Affairs, through the Board of Foreign Service Examinations, authority to take the FSO exams.
- If applicant has dual or multiple citizenships, he/she should submit a notarized affidavit stating that upon passing the examinations, he/she intends to renounce his/her allegiance to all of his/her countries of foreign citizenship; he/she must also submit a notarized affidavit that he/she is a permanent resident in the Philippines

Filipino citizens who are interested may submit their completed application forms and attachments to the Philippine Consulate General **on or before 29 November 2018**. Eligible applicants must pay a non-refundable **examination fee of Php 500.00** upon the submission of application forms and other required documents to the Consulate General. Applications with incomplete documentary requirements will not be accepted.
