AWARDS AND INCENTIVES FOR OVERSEAS FILIPINO CENTENARIANS

The Philippine Consulate General wishes to inform the Filipinos in Guam, Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI), Republic of Marshall Islands (RMI), Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) and Republic of Palau of the Guidelines on the Availment of Awards and Incentives for Overseas Filipino Centenarians under *Republic Act No. 10868 known as "An Act Honoring and Granting Additional Benefits and Privileges to Filipino Centenarians, and for other purposes, " or otherwise known as the "Centenarians Act of 2016"*. This is a tribute to **FILIPINO centenarians** who have spent their lifetime in contributing to nation building.

FILIPINO centenarians living in Guam, CNMI, RMI, FSM and Palau shall receive a **Letter of Felicitation** signed by the President of the Philippines, and a one-time cash award of **Php 100,000.00**. Awarding will be held on Centenarians Day (held every first Sunday of October).

The centenarian shall submit one (1) duly accomplished application form and present any one (1) of the following primary documentations to prove his/her entitlement:

- Authenticated Birth Certificate
- Valid Philippine Passport
